- 2. The data returned is stored in a result table, called the result-set.
- 3. SELECT column1, column2, ...

```
FROM table name;
```

Here, column1, column2, ... are the field names of the table you want to select data from. If you want to select all the fields available in the table, use the following syntax:

```
SELECT * FROM table name;
```

4. SELECT CustomerName, City, Country FROM Customers;

The following SQL statement selects the "CustomerName", "City", and "Country" columns from the "Customers" table.
