MY SQL SELECT STATEMENT

1. The `SELECT` statement is used to select data from a database.
2. The data returned is stored in a result table, called the result-set.
3. `SELECT column1, column2, ...`

`FROM table_name;`

Here, `column1`, `column2`, ... are the field names of the table you want to select data from. If you want to select all the fields available in the table, use the following syntax:

`SELECT * FROM table_name;`

4. `SELECT CustomerName, City, Country FROM Customers;`

The following SQL statement selects the "CustomerName", "City", and "Country" columns from the "Customers" table.
