2. It is used to extract only those records that fulfill a specified condition.

3. **WHERE Syntax**

```
SELECT column1, column2, ...FROM table_name WHERE condition;
```

4. **SELECT * FROM Customers**

```
WHERE Country = 'Mexico';
```

The following SQL statement selects all the customers from "Mexico":

5. **SELECT * FROM Customers WHERE CustomerID = 1;**
